I. General Regulations

1. These Admission Rules are developed by the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” (hereinafter – Admissions Committee) in accordance with the Terms of admission to higher educational institutions of Ukraine in 2022, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine of October 13, 2021 No. 1098 and registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 26, 2021 under No. 1542/37164 (hereinafter – Admission Rules).

2. The basis for the announcement of admission to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” to obtain a higher education are license for performing of educational activities of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine (Information on the implementation of educational activities in the field of higher education as of April 12, 2021 <https://mon.gov.ua/ua/ministerstvo/poslugi/licenzuvannya/vidomosti-pro-pravo-zdijsnennya-osvitnoyi-diyalnosti/vidomosti-pro-pravo-zdijsnennya-osvitnoyi-diyalnosti-u-sveri-vischoi-osviti/luganska-oblast-l>) and these Admission Rules approved by the Scientific Council of Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University (Minutes No. 5 of December 22, 2021)

3. Admission to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” is carried out on a competitive basis according to the relevant sources of funding specified in item 1 of Section III of these Rules.

4. Organization of entrants’ admission to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” is carried out by the Admissions Committee, the composition of which is approved by the Order of Rector of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, who is its Chairman. The Admissions Committee acts in accordance with the Regulations on the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, approved by the Scientific Council in accordance with Regulations on the Admissions Committee of a higher educational institution, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated October 15, 2015 No. 1085, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 04, 2015 under No. 1353/27798. Regulations on the Admissions Committee of higher educational institution are published on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” (<http://luguniv.edu.ua>).

The Rector of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” ensures compliance with the legislation of Ukraine, in particular the Terms of Admission, these Admission Rules, as well as openness and transparency of the Admissions Committee work.

The decision of the Admissions Committee, taken within its powers, is the basis for the issuance of the relevant Order by the Rector of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and/or the implementation of the admission campaign procedures.

All issues related to the admission to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, are decided by the Admissions Committee at its meetings. The decisions of the Admissions Committee are published on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” (<http://luguniv.edu.ua>) no later than the next day after the relevant decision is made.

5. In these Rules, the terms are used in the following meanings:

targeted placement of state-funded places – providing the entrant with a recommendation for enrollment in places of study at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) on the basis of his score;

open bid – the bid, for which the number of places for study under the state order is determined during the targeted placement of state-funded places within the qualification minimum and the maximum volume of the state order or equal to zero in case of impossibility to form the qualification minimum of the state order;

entrance test – assessment of the entrant’s willingness to obtain a higher education, which is conducted in the form of external independent evaluation, entrance exam, interview on a competitive subject(s), creative competition, creative test, professional entrance test, single entrance exam, single professional entrance exam, presentation of research proposals or achievements;

entrance exam – a form of entrance examination, which provides assessing the knowledge, skills and abilities of the entrant in the competitive subject, the results of which are credited to the score of the entrant, or the results of which the entrant is allowed to participate in competitive selection or other entrance examinations;

entrant – the person who submitted the application(s) for admission to participation in the competitive selection for one (several) bid;

single professional entrance exam – form of entrance examination for admission to study for obtaining Master’s Degree on the basis of Bachelor’s Degree, Master’s Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist), which involves the use of organizational and technological processes implementation of external independent evaluation;

single entrance exam – form of entrance examination in a foreign language (English, German, French or Spanish) for admission to study for obtaining Master's Degree on the basis of Bachelor’s Degree, Master’s Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist), which involves the use of organizational and technological processes implementation of external independent evaluation;

qualification minimum of the state order – the minimum number of entrants that can be recommended for an open bid during the targeted placement of state-funded places to open an intake for it (only for programme subject areas that are

included in the List of programme subject areas which are provided with special support);

quota for foreigners – a certain part of the volume of state-funded places used for the admission of entrants from the number of:

foreigners who come to study in accordance with international agreements of Ukraine;

foreign Ukrainians whose status is certified by a certificate of a foreign Ukrainian and who do not reside permanently in Ukraine;

quota-1 – a certain part of the maximum volume of state-funded places (for open bids) or the total volume of state-funded places (for fixed bids), which can be used for admission of entrants on the basis of complete general secondary education, eligible for admission on the basis of admission exams (except for persons entitled to quota-2), and orphans, children deprived of parental care, persons from their number,

quota-2 – a certain part of the maximum volume of state-funded places (for open bids) or the total volume of state-funded places (for fixed bids) in higher educational institutions, which can be used for admission of entrants on the basis of complete general secondary education, eligible for admission on the basis of entrance exams in accordance with the Procedure of admission to institutions of higher, professional pre-higher and vocational education for the residents from the temporarily occupied territory of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and Sevastopol city, temporarily occupied territory of certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts, territory of the settlements located on the contact line, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated March 1, 2021 No. 271, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on April 15, 2021 under No. 505/36127 (hereinafter – order No. 271);

quota-3 – a certain part of the regional order, which can be used by state or municipal higher educational institutions for admission to study on the basis of complete general secondary education of persons who received it in educational institutions in the relevant administrative-territorial unit;

quota-4 – a certain part of the maximum volume of state-funded places (for open bids) or the total volume of state-funded places (for fixed bids), which can be used for admission of entrants on the basis of complete general secondary education, eligible for priority enrollment in institutions of higher (professional higher) medical, artistic and pedagogical education, in accordance with Paragraph 4 of Part 3 of Article 44 of the Law of Ukraine “On Higher Education” and the Procedure for exercising the right to priority enrollment in institutions of higher (professional higher) medical, artistic and pedagogical education by state order of persons who have concluded an agreement on working for at least three years in rural areas or urban settlements, approved by the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of May 30, 2018 No. 417 (as amended by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of June 3, 2020 No. 454) (hereinafter – Order 417);

bid – an offer of the higher educational institution (separate structural subdivision of the higher educational institution, structural subdivision of the higher educational institution located in a settlement other than the location of the higher educational institution) on the number of places for admission of entrants to a certain

level of higher education, educational programme(s), mode of study, course, list of competitive subjects, creative tests and creative competitions, duration of study on the basis of the obtained educational level or degree (educational-qualification level). There are fixed and non-budget bids. If the bid combines several educational programmes, etc., the Admission Rules specify the order of distribution of students between educational programmes and the terms of selection of their students (for Junior Bachelor, Bachelor (Master of Medical, Pharmaceutical and Veterinary Specialties) on the basis of complete general secondary education before the end of the first year of study, in other cases not earlier than three months after the start of training);

score – comprehensive assessment of the entrant’s achievements, which is calculated on the results of entrance test and other competitive indicators with an accuracy of 0.001 in accordance with these Terms and Rules of Admission;

competitive selection – procedure for selection of entrants for bids on the basis of score and (if used) priorities of students’ applications for higher education (on a competitive basis);

competitive subject – subject (discipline), the level of academic achievement of which is taken into account during the competitive selection for study at a higher educational institution;

non-budget bid – bid for which places for study at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) are not provided;

the right to the enrollment under quotas – the right to enroll in higher educational institutions under quota-1, quota-2, quota-4, quota for foreigners, which is implemented in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission;

the right to priority enrollment to obtain a higher education in medical, artistic and pedagogical specialties - the right of the entrant, provided by law, to enroll for study at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) in the field of study 22 “Healthcare” by the programme subject areas 224 “Technologies of Medical Diagnostics and Treatment”, 227 “Physical Therapy, Ergotherapy”, in the field of study 02 “Culture and Arts” by the programme subject areas 023 “Fine Arts, Decorative Arts, Restoration”, 024 “Choreography”, 025 “Musical Arts”, in the field of study 01 “Education/Pedagogy” by the programme subject areas 012 “Pre-school Education”, 013 “Primary Education”, 014 “Secondary Education (by subject specialization)”, 015 “Vocational Education (by specializations)”, 016 “Special Education”, 017 “Physical Education and Sports” in case of concluding an agreement on working for at least three years in rural areas or urban-type settlements, which is implemented in accordance with Procedure 417 and these Rules and Terms of Admission;

presentation of research proposals or achievements – a form of entrance test that can be provided during the admission for the Doctor of Philosophy Degree, which consists in hearing and discussing the scientific message of the entrant;

priority – the order determined by the entrant during the submission of applications (where 1 is the highest priority) of their consideration in the case of targeted placement of state-funded places;

rating list of entrants - the list of entrants in the order of enrollment in the bid, which is formed in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission;

interview – a form of entrance test, which involves assessing the preparedness (assessment of knowledge, skills and abilities of the entrant in the competitive subject(s) and motivation of the entrant, based on which a protocol decision to make a recommendation to the entrant;

creative test – a form of entrance test, which involves determining the adequacy of the entrant’s level of creative and/or physical abilities to participate in the competitive selection for a particular bid in cases provided by these Rules and Terms of Admission to fixed bids, based on complete general secondary education. According to the Admission Rules to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” for a certain bid, a creative test may be excluded from the list of mandatory entrance examinations;

creative competition – a form of entrance test for admission to obtain Bachelor’s Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education, which involves testing and assessing the creative and/or physical abilities of the entrant (including previously specialized education) required for higher education in the programme subject area included in the list of programme subject areas for which admission is based on the level of creative and/or physical abilities of entrants, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated October 15, 2015 No. 1085, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 04, 2015 under No. 1351/27796 (as amended by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated October 13, 2017 No. 1378). The result of the creative competition is evaluated on a scale determined by these Rules and Terms of Admission;

technical error – error made by the authorized person of the Admissions Committee for the acceptance and consideration of applications when entering information about the entrant or application to the Unified State Electronic Database on Education, which is confirmed by an act of technical error;

professional entrance exam – a form of entrance test for admission on the basis of obtained (or such) degree or educational-qualification level of higher education, which involves testing the ability to master the educational programme of a certain level of higher education on the basis of previously acquired competencies;

fixed bid - a bid with a predetermined number of places for study at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order);

The term “voucher” is used in the meaning given in the Law of Ukraine “On Employment of the Population”.

The term “foreign Ukrainians” is used in the meaning given in the Law of Ukraine “On Foreign Ukrainians”.

Other terms are used in the meanings given in the Law of Ukraine “On Higher Education”.

II. Admission to higher education

1. To apply for higher education the following persons are accepted:

persons who have completed general secondary education or the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, the professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, the educational degree of Junior Bachelor – to obtain Bachelor’s Degree;

persons who have obtained Bachelor’s, Master’s Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) – to obtain Master’s Degree;

persons who have obtained Master’s Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) – for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy.

To obtain a degree in another programme subject area persons who have previously obtained the same or higher degree (level) of higher education or receive it for at least one year and fully implement the individual curriculum are also accepted. The condition for enrollment of a student for simultaneous study in another programme subject area at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” is the fulfillment of requirements similar to the requirements for entrants to the relevant educational programmes. These requirements can be met during the first year of study.

2. Entrants are accepted for the first year. Persons who have obtained the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, the professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, the educational degree of Junior Bachelor, State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” may recalculate ECTS credits, the maximum amount of which is determined by the standard of higher education bachelor (in the absence of standard – no more than 120 ECTS credits). Such persons may be admitted to the second or senior years or to the first year (with a reduced period of study). To obtain Bachelor’s Degree in another programme subject area, persons may be admitted to the first or senior year (including reduced period of study).

Students at the educational-qualification level of Specialist on the basis of complete general secondary education or at the level of Junior Specialist of Medical, Pharmaceutical and Veterinary Specialties who have been expelled or interrupted their studies in connection due to academic leave may be renewed to continue their studies for obtaining Master’s Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education or educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist in the same or related programme subject area within the field of study at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” or in another higher educational institution.

3. Admission is carried out by programme subject areas (specializations) in accordance with the List of fields of study and program subject areas in higher education, approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated April 29, 2015 No. 266 and interdisciplinary educational (educational-scientific) programmes that meet Requirements for interdisciplinary educational (scientific) programmes approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated February 1, 2021 No. 128 “On approval of Requirements for interdisciplinary educational (scientific) programmes”, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on April 06, 2021 No. 454/36076.

Admission of entrants is based on bids, which are independently formed by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and submitted to

the Unified State Electronic Database on Education within the terms specified in these Rules and Terms of Admission.

The names of bids are formed without marks and abbreviations in the state language and may be duplicated in other languages.

4. Peculiarities of admission to higher educational institutions of persons whose place of residence is the temporarily occupied territory of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the Sevastopol city, temporarily occupied territory of certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts, territory of settlements located on the contact line or moved from it after January 1, 2022, are determined by order No. 271.

5. Peculiarities of admission to higher educational institutions under the educational-professional programme of Master's Degree in programme subject area 281 "Public Administration" under the state order of the National Agency of Ukraine for Civil Service Affairs are determined by the Procedure for admission to the Master's programme in "Public Management and Administration" in the field of study "Public Management and Administration", approved by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated July 29, 2009 No. 789.

III. Sources of funding for higher education

1. Funding for the training of students is provided:

at the expense of state budget expenditures (state order);

at the expense of targeted soft state loans. Obtaining targeted soft state loans for higher education is carried out in accordance with the Procedure for preferential lending for vocational and higher education, approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated August 29, 2018 No. 673;

by vouchers;

at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities (under the terms of the agreement, in particular at the expense of grants received by State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" for research, which provides training for Doctors of Philosophy or Doctors of Science).

2. Citizens of Ukraine have the right to obtain higher education free of charge on a competitive basis in accordance with the standards of higher education, if a citizen obtains a certain degree for the first time at the expense of the state or local budget in state and municipal higher educational institutions.

Persons who have obtained the educational-qualification level of Specialist at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) may obtain Master's Degree only at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, except as provided in item 5 of this Section.

3. A person may enter State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" to obtain Master's Degree on the basis of Bachelor's, Master's and educational-qualification level of Specialist obtained in another programme subject area (field of study) (subject to the requirements of Paragraph 9 of item 1 of Section II of these Rules), subject to successful passing of entrance tests.

Persons who apply for Bachelor's Degree on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, the professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, the educational degree of Junior Bachelor can be enrolled in the state order for the first year for a reduced period of study only in case of admission to the same or related programme subject areas within the field of study, as well as in the programme subject areas listed in the List of programme subject areas, which are provided with special support (Appendix 2).

4. Citizens of Ukraine who have not completed their studies at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) at a certain level have the right to re-enroll to obtain higher education free of charge at State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" at the same level under terms of reimbursement to the state or local budget of funds spent on training services, in accordance with the Procedure for reimbursement of state or local budget expenditures on training services, approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated August 26, 2015 No. 658.

5. Citizens of Ukraine have the right to obtain higher education free of charge in the second programme subject area at State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University":

if due to their state of health they have lost the opportunity to perform official duties according to the previously obtained qualification, which is confirmed by the conclusions of the medical and social expert commission, and in other cases provided by law;

if they have a referral for training issued by the state customer in accordance with the law.

6. Targeted soft state loans are provided to persons enrolled in higher education by Full-time or Intermittent (Off-Campus) education on the basis of agreements concluded between State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" and an individual or legal entity, namely:

preferential long-term loan for higher education – for students who in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Ensuring the Rights and Freedoms of Internally Displaced Persons" are registered in the manner prescribed by law as internally displaced persons, as well as persons among them until their graduation from State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University", but no longer than until they reach the age of 23;

preferential long-term loan for higher education – for students of higher educational institutions, regardless of ownership, the list of which is approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, until they reach 35 years.

7. Foreigners and stateless persons, in particular foreign Ukrainians permanently residing in Ukraine, persons recognized as refugees and persons in need of additional protection have the right to higher education on an equal footing with citizens of Ukraine, in particular at the expense of the state or local budget.

8. Persons studying at State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" have the right to study simultaneously in several educational programmes, as well as in several higher educational institutions.

Simultaneous study in two or more programme subject areas (specializations, subject specialties, educational programmes, levels, degrees, modes of education) at the expense of state or local budgets is not allowed, except in cases of combination of fields, programme subject areas, specializations (subject specialties) in one educational programme, or obtaining the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, the professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, the educational degree of Junior Bachelor which is considered to be a simultaneous acquisition of Bachelor's and Master's Degrees.

9. Entrants for Bachelor's Degree based on a complete general secondary education are eligible for competitive selection for vacant places of the state order and may be recommended or transferred to such places if they have a score of at least 125.000. Restrictions on transfer to vacant places of the state order do not apply to the persons specified in item 12 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission.

10. State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University", which provides training for higher education on the terms of the state order and/or at the expense of targeted soft state loans set the cost of training in accordance with the Procedure for forming the minimum tuition fee for higher education based on indicative cost approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated March 3, 2020 No. 191.

IV. Volumes of admission and volumes of the state order

1. Admission is carried out within the licensed volume for a certain level of higher education or for a certain educational programme, which provides for the assignment of professional qualifications in professions for which additional regulations have been introduced. The licensed volume determines the maximum total number of students who can enroll at State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" during one calendar year (from January 1 to December 31), be renewed or transferred to it from other higher educational institutions, for higher education of the appropriate level, or for the relevant educational programme.

2. Admission to study by state order (at the expense of the state budget) is carried out on programme subject areas and modes of study, according to which it is formed by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. The Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and other state customers determine from certain ones the lists of programme subject areas and specializations for which the state order is formed and placed, in accordance with the List of state customers' orders, which determine programme subject areas and specialization of certain programme subject areas for which the formation and placement of the state order is carried out. Admission to study at the expense of the state and local budgets (by state order) can be carried out by State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University", which has obtained a license for educational activities at a certain level of higher education and/or under a certain educational programme from professions for which additional

regulation has been introduced, no later than December 31, 2021, at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities – no later than May 31, 2022.

3. The admission volume under the state order on the basis of complete general secondary education is determined in general for all executors of the state order, separately according to the modes of study:

by fields of study:

23 “Social work”;

by intersectoral groups:

fields of study 07 “Management and Administration”, 24 “Services”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, programme subject area 051 “Economics” of the field of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”;

field of study 09 “Biology”, programme subject area 101 “Ecology” of the field of study 10 “Natural Sciences”;

fields of study 06 “Journalism”, 29 “International Relations”, programme subject area 052 “Political Science” of the field of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”;

by subsectoral groups:

programme subject areas 012 “Pre-school Education” and 013 “Primary Education” of the field of study 01 “Education/Pedagogy”;

subject areas 014.04 “Mathematics”, 014.06 “Chemistry”, 014.08 “Physics”, 014.09 “Informatics”, 014.10 “Labor training and technology”, 014.15 “Natural Sciences” of programme subject area 014 “Secondary Education” of the field of study 01 “Education/Pedagogy”;

all specializations of programme subject area 015 “Vocational Education (by specializations)”, except for specialization 015.39 “Digital Technologies”;

programme subject area 032 “History and Archaeology” of the field of study 03 “Humanities”;

specializations 035.043 “Germanic Languages and Literatures (including translation), first language is German”, 035.051 “Romance Languages and Literatures (including translation), first language is Spanish”, 035.055 “Romance Languages and Literatures (including translation), first language is French”, 035.065 “Oriental Languages and Literatures (including translation), first language is Chinese”, 035.069 Oriental Languages and Literatures (including translation), first language is Japanese” of programme subject area 035 “Philology” of the field of study 03 “Humanities”;

programme subject areas 053 “Psychology” and 054 “Sociology” of the field of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”;

programme subject areas 102 “Chemistry”, 104 “Physics and Astronomy”, of the field of study 10 “Natural Sciences”;

programme subject area 111 “Mathematics” of the field of study 11 “Mathematics and Statistics”;

programme subject areas 224 “Technologies of Medical Diagnostics and Treatment”, 227 “Physical Therapy, Ergotherapy”, of the field of study 22 “Healthcare”;

subject areas 014.12 “Fine Arts”, 014.13 “Musical Arts” of programme subject area 014 “Secondary Education” of the field of study 01 “Education/Pedagogy”;

other programme subject areas (specializations), as well as for Master’s Degree on the basis of a higher education degree in programme subject areas 05 “Social and Behavioral Sciences”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International Relations”, except as provided in Items 4, 6 of this Section, and its distribution between the bids of higher educational institutions is carried out using targeted placement of state-funded places.

The division of the state order for the training of Masters in higher educational institutions in the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine is carried out using the Criteria for competitive selection of executors of the state order for the training of masters in higher educational institutions under the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated May 3, 2018 No. 445, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on May 24, 2018 under No. 625/32077.

The distribution of the state order for the training of Bachelors on the basis of the educational-qualification level of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, the professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, the educational degree of Junior Bachelor, is carried out using the Criteria of competitive selection of state order executants for bachelors’ training on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist in higher educational institutions belonging to the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated May 6, 2019 No. 611, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on May 29, 2019 under No. 559/33530.

In all other cases, the distribution of the amount of admission by state order between higher educational institutions is carried out by state customers by programme subject areas (specializations) and modes of education, and its distribution between fixed bids higher educational institutions carry out independently, unless otherwise specified by the state customer.

4. The admission volume under the state order in higher educational institutions operating in Donetsk and Luhansk regions is determined by the state customer for each higher educational institution, programme subject area (specialization) and mode of study, and its distribution among fixed bids of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” carries out independently.

The admission volume under the state order in the programme subject area of the field of study 01 “Education/Pedagogy” (except for specialties 011 “Educational, Pedagogical Sciences”, 017 “Physical Education and Sports”) for persons entitled to priority enrollment in higher pedagogical educational institutions, in accordance with Paragraph 6 of Part 3 of Article 44 of the Law of Ukraine “On Higher Education” and the Procedure for exercising the right to priority enrollment in institutions of higher (professional higher) medical, artistic and pedagogical education by state order of persons who have concluded an agreement on working for at least three years in rural areas or urban settlements, approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine on May 30, 2018 No. 417, determines the state customer for each higher educational

institution, programme subject area (specialization) and mode of study, and higher educational institutions carry out independently its distribution among fixed bids.

5. The admission volume under the state order on the basis of complete general secondary education by specializations 014.02 “Secondary Education. Language and Literature (specifying the language)” and specialization 016.02 “Oligophrenic pedagogy”, programme subject areas 016 “Special Education”, 017 “Physical Education and Sports” of the field of study 01 “Education / Pedagogy”, programme subject areas 021 “Audiovisual Arts and Production”, 022 “Design”, 023 “Fine Arts, Decorative Art, Restoration”, 024 “Choreography”, 025 “Musical Art” of the field of study 02 “Culture and Arts” is determined by government customers for State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and each mode of study, and its distribution among fixed bids of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” carries out independently.

6. The admission volume at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities for fixed bids is determined by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” within the difference between the licensed volume and the total (maximum) volume of the state order, if necessary, the provided reserve for renewal or transfer to it from other higher educational institutions for higher education of the appropriate level or according to the relevant educational programme. This volume may be adjusted taking into account the actual received state order places and in cases of allocation of additional public procurement, transfer to vacant public procurement and redistribution of places between modes of education, but may not be reduced for the bid in the period between the start of acceptance of documents and applications and the formation of the first list of recommended for this bid.

The admission volume on a non-budget bid is determined by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” within the licensed volume for a certain higher education level or for a certain educational programme, which provides for the professional qualification’s assignment in professions for which additional regulation has been introduced.

7. Total volume of state-funded places for fixed bids, quota-1, quota-2, quota-4, quota for foreigners for fixed bids, admission volume at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities for fixed bids, admission volume at non-budget bids are published on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and are defined in these Rules (after receiving the necessary information from the state customer).

9. In accordance with Paragraph 30 of the Procedure for professional development of pedagogical and scientific-pedagogical workers, approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated August 21, 2019 No. 800, State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, which trains students by state order, may provide referrals by state order to pedagogical (scientific-pedagogical) employees of educational institutions and scientific-methodical institutions by Part-time (evening) or Intermittent (Off-Campus) mode of study within vacancies of the relevant programme subject area (specialization) and year of study, except the first, in

case of the absence of students at the expense of individuals (legal) entities and have the right to transfer to state-funded places in accordance with the laws.

6. For admission to study for Master's Degree on the basis of Bachelor's Degree, the Admission Rules set additional deadlines for applications and documents, competitive selection and enrollment at the expense of individuals and legal entities from September 1 to November 30. The results of single professional entrance examination and/or single entrance exam (including a specially organized session of single entrance exam) obtained in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission, or the results of the professional entrance exam and/or entrance exam in a foreign language in a higher educational institution in the cases provided by these Terms.

7. For those categories of entrants for whom the deadlines for applications and documents, competitive selection and enrollment are not set in Items 1-6 of this Section, these deadlines are determined by these Admission Rules. In this case, enrollment by state order ends no later than September 15, except as provided in Sections XIII, XIV of the Terms of Admission. Enrollment at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities ends no later than November 30. Registration and work of entrants' electronic cabinets ends on September 30.

8. State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" provides for an additional set of entrants at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities on a Full-time mode to obtain Bachelor's Degree on the basis of a complete general secondary education of Junior Specialist, professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor provided that such entrants are enrolled by September 30.

9 State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" in the Admission Rules may provide for the enrollment of entrants at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities to obtain Master's Degree on the basis of Master's Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) in several stages (including the date of admission) subject to enrollment of such entrants by November 30.

The results of single professional entrance exam and/or single entrance exam (including a specially organized session of single entrance exam) obtained in accordance with Item 4-5 of this Section or the results of the professional entrance exam and/or entrance exam in a foreign language drawn up at State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" shall be used in cases provided by these Rules and Terms of Admission.

VI. The procedure for reception of applications and documents for participation in the competitive selection for higher education

1. Entrants for higher education submit applications:

- only in electronic form, except for the cases specified in this Item;
- only in paper form:

- to exercise the right to take exams (if entrant does not have at least one of the certificates of external independent evaluation of years 2019-2022), an interview, in accordance with the Order No. 271 in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission;
- to exercise the right to re-education free of charge at the expense of the budget in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission;
- if there are discrepancies in the data of the entrant in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education (surname, name, patronymic (if any), date of birth, sex, citizenship, etc.) and in the relevant document on previous education and in the certificate of external independent evaluation;
- in case of submission of a foreign document on education;
- in the case of submission of documents by foreigners and stateless persons;
- in the case of submission of a document on previously acquired education, issued before the introduction of photopolymer technologies for their manufacture;
- in case of submitting an application after the expiration of the electronic cabinets;
- to exercise the right to accrual additional points provided for in the Paragraph 9 of Sub-item 1 of Item 7 of Section VII of these Terms;
- in case of impossibility to register an electronic cabinet or submit an application in electronic form for other reasons, which is confirmed by the certificate of the Admissions Committee of the higher educational institution.

Entrants referred to in Paragraph 4 of this Item may submit applications in electronic form with the subsequent submission of documents confirming the right to enter the interview, which must be submitted within the application period, in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission.

To exercise the right by the results of entrance exams in competitive subjects at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and/or quota-1 (subject to at least one external independent evaluation certificate), before submitting an electronic application the entrant personally submits the original document(s) confirming his right to special conditions for participation in the competitive selection to the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”.

Entrants can submit up to five applications for public procurement in fixed bids, and up to twenty applications for non-budget bids.

2. The application in electronic form is submitted by filling in the electronic form online and is considered by the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” in the manner prescribed by the laws.

State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” is setting up a counseling center at the Admissions Committee to assist entrants in applying

electronically. Entrants can contact the counseling center of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” to create an electronic cabinet, submit applications in electronic form, upload supplement to the educational document on the basis of which admission is based, certificate of registration of residence (if necessary) in accordance with Appendix 13 to the Rules of registration of residence and The procedure for the transfer of information by the registration authorities to the Unified State Demographic Register, approved by the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated March 2, 2016 No. 207.

3. The entrant submits the application in paper form in person to the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”. Details of each application in paper form are registered by the authorized person of the Admissions Committee in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education on the day of acceptance of the application.

4. In the application, entrants indicate the bid that indicates programme subject area (subject area, specialization, educational programme(s)) and the mode of study.

Entrants must indicate one of these options when applying for fixed bids:

“I apply to participate in the competition for the place of state or regional order and to participate in the competition for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities in case of failure to receive a recommendation on this bid from the state or local budget (state or regional order)”;

“I apply to participate in the competition exclusively for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, informed about the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to places of state or regional order”.

When submitting applications for a non-budget bid, entrants apply to participate in the competition exclusively at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities and are warned about the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to public procurement.

Entrants for Junior Bachelor’s Degree, Bachelor’s Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education and entrants for Master’s Degree on the basis of Bachelor’s Degree, Master’s Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) for programme subject areas in the fields of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International Relations”, applying for public procurement on a Full-time or Intermittent (Off-Campus) mode of study, in each application indicate its priority; the priority indicator 1 (one) means the highest priority.

The priority of applications specified by the entrant cannot be changed.

Entrants submit separate applications to participate in the competition for admission in various modes of study.

5. The entrant must present the originals in person when submitting the paper application:

- a document (one of the documents) certifying the person provided by the Law of Ukraine “On the Unified State Demographic Register and

Documents Certifying Citizenship of Ukraine, a Person's Identity or Special Status";

- military registration document (for conscripts – military card or temporary conscript certificate, and for conscripts – certificate of registration in conscription stations);
- a document (state standard) on a previously obtained educational degree (educational-qualification level), on the basis of which admission is carried out, and supplement to it;
- documents confirming the entrant's right to enroll in an interview, to participate in the competition based on the results of entrance exams and/or quota-1, quota-2 or quota-3 on the basis of complete general secondary education, to participate in the competition for entrance exams to obtain Master's Degree on the basis of Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) instead of a single entrance exam in a foreign language and/or a single professional entrance exam.

Entrants living in the temporarily occupied territory of Ukraine or relocated from it after January 1, 2022, as well as entrants living in territories where public authorities are temporarily not exercising their powers, submit documents taking into account the features provided by Order No. 271.

If for objective reasons there is no document on the obtained educational degree (educational-qualification level), a certificate of the state enterprise "Inforesurs" or an Extract from the Register of educational documents of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education on its acquisition may be submitted, in particular without submitting a supplement to the document on educational (educational-qualification) level.

6. To the paper form application the entrant adds:

- a copy of a document (one of the documents) certifying the person provided by the Law of Ukraine "On the Unified State Demographic Register and Documents Certifying Citizenship of Ukraine, a Person's Identity or Special Status";
- a copy of the taxpayer's card;
- a copy of the military registration document (for conscripts – a military card or a temporary conscript certificate, and for conscripts – a certificate of registration in conscription stations);
- a copy and the original of the document (state standard) on the previously obtained educational (educational-qualification) level on the basis of which the admission is made, and a copy of a supplement to it;
- a copy and original of the external independent evaluation certificate;
- four 3 × 4 cm color photographs;
- a contract for training.

To participate in the entrance exam, creative competition for public procurement on the basis of complete general secondary education, except for the application for creative competition (in electronic or paper form determined by the

Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”), entrants submit a copy of an identity document; a photograph 3 × 4 cm; certificate of the educational institution on completion of full general secondary education in case of lack of information on the obtained document on complete general secondary education in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education by July 10, a copy of the document confirming the entrant’s right to participate in the entrance exam. Entrants are not required to submit other documents to participate in the entrance exam or creative competition.

On the website (web page) of the university State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” may provide electronic registration for participation in the entrance exam and creative competition if the entrant submits scanned copies (photocopies) of the documents.

Entrants who pass entrance exams and creative competitions are allowed to participate in them if they have the original identity document, the original document confirming the right of the entrant to participate in the entrance exam, and the exam sheet with a photo.

The entrant submits other copies of documents, if it is due to the special conditions of admission to the relevant bids, established by laws, within the time limits set for the receipt of documents.

7. Copies of documents certifying the grounds for obtaining special conditions for enrollment in the interview, participation in the competition based on the results of entrance exams and/or quota-1, quota-2 based on complete general secondary education, special conditions for participation in the competition based on entrance exams when applying for Master’s Degree on the basis of Bachelor’s Degree, Master’s Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist), the entrant submits in person when submitting documents in paper form in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission or according to them. Failure to submit documents in time, certifying the grounds for obtaining special conditions for enrollment by interview, to participate in the competition based on the results of entrance exams and/or quota-1, quota-2 on the basis of complete general secondary education, make their implementation impossible.

8. Copies of documents certifying the grounds for obtaining special conditions by a person enrolled in training at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, for transfer to vacant places of the state order and at the expense of targeted soft state loans the entrant submits in person at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities:

for the degree of Junior Bachelor, Bachelor on the basis of complete general secondary education – no later than August 11;

to obtain Master’s Degree in programme subject areas of fields of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International Relations” – no later than August 15.

Failure to submit documents in time, certifying the grounds for obtaining special conditions for transfer to vacant positions of the state order and at the expense of targeted soft state loans, makes their implementation impossible.

9. Copies of documents, in addition to the identity document and the military registration document, are certified by the originals of the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” to which they are submitted. Copies of documents without presentation of originals are not accepted.

10. The Admissions Committee checks grounds for obtaining special conditions for admission by the interview, participation in the competition based on the results of entrance exams and/or quota-1, quota-2 based on a complete general secondary education, special conditions for participation in the competition based on entrance exams during the admission to Master's Degree on the basis of Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) and special conditions to enroll at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities to obtain Bachelor's Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education, Master's Degree on the basis of the obtained Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) for transfer to vacant places of the state order and at the expense of targeted soft state loans.

The Admissions Committee checks the grade point average (hereinafter - GPA) submitted in paper form (calculates in case of absence), approves it by its decision and adds information on the GPA of the educational document in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education. If entrant submits an application in electronic form, the Admissions Committee checks the GPA of the educational document on the basis of its scanned copy (photocopy).

11. The Admissions Committee considers entrant`s applications and documents and decides on admission to the competitive selection for enrollment at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” within three working days from the date of registration of the application in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education, but no later than the next day, in case of passing entrance tests - no later than the next day after the end of the entrance tests.

12. The fact of entrant`s acquaintance with the Admission Rules, available license and certificate of accreditation of the relevant educational programme, as well as the fact of the presence/absence of grounds for participation in the competition based on the results of entrance exams, enrollment by interview, enrollment by quota-1, quota-2, quota-3, quota-4 are recorded in the entrant`s application and are confirmed by his personal signature when submitting the application.

In case of submitting documents for non-accredited educational programmes the fact of entrant`s acquaintance with Part 6 of Article 7 of the Law of Ukraine “On Higher Education” is recorded in a written notice of awareness of the lack of accreditation and is confirmed by his personal signature when submitting the application in a paper form.

The entrant has the right to cancel previously submitted application, registered and admitted to the competition in his own electronic cabinet before the deadline for electronic submissions to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” without the right to submit a new application with the same priority.

Paper statement registered in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education can be canceled by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National

University” on the basis of the decision of Admissions Committee before the completion of paper form applications, in case of technical error while entering relevant data in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education, confirmed by the act of technical error, which is formed and printed out of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education. The canceled application is considered as not submitted, and the fact of such submission is annulled in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education.

Electronic application registered in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education can be canceled by the Technical Administrator of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education based on the official decision of the Administrator of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education no later than one day before the end of submission of electronic applications in case that a technical error is detected while putting in the relevant data in to the Unified State Electronic Database on Education. The canceled application is considered as not submitted, and the fact of such submission is annulled in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education.

The Technical Administrator notifies the entrant about the cancellation of application by mobile or electronic means on the day of its cancellation, after which the entrant may submit a new application with the same priority.

13. During the admission of persons, who submit a document on the degree (level) of education obtained abroad (hereinafter - the Document), the procedure for recognizing and establishing the equivalence of the Document is mandatory and is carried out in accordance with the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated May 5, 2015 No. 504 “Some issues of recognition foreign educational documents in Ukraine”, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on May 27, 2015 under No. 614/27059.

14. When submitting applications and documents for Junior Bachelor`s Degree, Bachelor`s Degree on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist may be accepted as documents on the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist that are made in accordance with the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated September 9, 2020 No. 811 “On documents On Higher Education (scientific degrees)” and documents on the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, prepared in accordance with the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated July 22, 2015 No. 645 “On documents on professional (vocational) education of the state standard and supplements to them”.

VII. Competitive selection, its organization and conduct

1. Competitive selection for higher educational degrees is based on the results of entrance tests:

to enter the first year of study for Junior Bachelor's Degree, Bachelor's Degree based on complete general secondary education - in the form of external independent evaluation, creative tests, creative competitions, entrance exams or interviews provided by cases of these Rules and Terms of Admission. In year 2022, certificates of external independent evaluation of years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 are accepted.

If a foreign language is set as a competitive subject, the entrant has the right to submit his grade from certificates in one foreign language (English, German, French or Spanish) at his own discretion;

to enter the study for Master's Degree on the basis of a higher educational degree by programme subject areas of fields of study 05 "Social and Behavioral Science", 06 "Journalism", 07 "Management and Administration", 28 "Public Management and Administration", 29 "International Relations" – in the form of a single entrance exam in a foreign language (under terms of successful pass of the single entrance exam in a foreign language, passed in years 2020, 2021 or 2022 and each block of single professional entrance exam passed in the year of entry) or entrance examinations in the cases provided by these Rules and Terms of Admission;

to enter the study for Master's Degree on the basis of higher educational degree (educational-qualification level) obtained in other programme subject areas in the form of a single entrance exam in a foreign language (except as provided in these Terms), passed in years 2020, 2021 or 2022, and single professional entrance exams passed in the year of entry;

to enter the study for Bachelor's Degree on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor - in the form of external independent evaluation and vocational entrance examination in cases established by these Rules and Terms of Admission. In year 2022, certificates of external independent evaluation for years 2019-2022 are accepted;

to enter the study for Bachelor's Degree on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor - in field of study 22 "Healthcare" instead of a single professional entrance exam, entrants submit the results of the integrated exam KROK-M, if they passed it. The structure of the relevant single professional entrance exams in the educational institution should correspond to the structure of the integrated exam KROK-M.

in other cases - in the forms established by the Rules of Admission.

In the case of submitting documents for participation in the competitive selection of persons with special educational needs State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" provides appropriate conditions to pass entrance exams, creative competitions and interviews.

2. Competitive selection is based on the score, which is calculated in accordance with the Terms and these Admission Rules.

3. For competitive selection of persons, who enter the first year Bachelor's Degree (Master of Medical, Pharmaceutical and Veterinary Specialties) on the basis of complete general secondary education they should point certificate(s) of external independent evaluation of three competitive subjects, Junior Bachelor - of two competitive subjects. List of competitive subjects, creative tests and creative competitions for enter Junior Bachelor's Degree, Bachelor's Degree in fixed and non-budget bids on the basis of complete general secondary education is defined in Appendix 4 of Terms of Admission.

Creative competition in programme subject areas for which it is provided, or one of the lists of the second and third subjects specified in the table is set as the second competitive subject for admission to Bachelor's Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education, that is offered at the choice of entrant. Creative tests for non-budget bids are set by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” to its own prosecutions.

If a foreign language is set as a competitive subject, the entrant has the right to submit a grade from certificates in one foreign language (English, German, French or Spanish) on his own.

For bids in programme subject areas (specializations) in field of study 01 “Education/Pedagogy”, which provide training for secondary education institutions with instruction in Bulgarian, Crimean Tatar, Moldovan, Modern Greek, Polish, Romanian, Slovak, Hungarian languages or learning these languages, the higher educational institution may add an entrance exam in the relevant language instead of the third competitive subject.

4. For the competitive selection on the basis of Bachelor's or Master's Degrees, to enter Master's Degree the following are enrolled:

1) to enter programme subject areas of fields of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 08 “Law”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International relations”:

results of single entrance exam in foreign language in the form of foreign language test (English, German, French or Spanish) or entrance examination in cases provided in Items 15, 16 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission;

results of the single professional entrance exams, the components of which are subject test and test of general educational law competence (hereinafter - TGELC) or entrance examination in cases provided in Items 15, 16 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission;

2) to enter other programme subject areas:

results of single entrance exam in foreign language in the form of foreign language test (English, German, French or Spanish) or an entrance test in foreign language (in cases provided by these Rules and Terms of Admission);

results of single professional entrance exam. Persons who in the year of admission passed the single state qualifying exam at the first (Bachelor's) level of higher education in the relevant programme subject area in accordance with the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated May 19, 2021 No. 497 “On certification of entrants for professional higher education and higher education at the first (Bachelor`s) Degree and second (Master's) Degree in the form of a single state qualifying exam”, the result is counted as the result of the single professional entrance exam.

5. For competitive selection of persons who enter the study for Doctor of Philosophy Degree, grades for entrance exams in programme subject area and foreign

language are credited, as well as the results of other forms of entrance tests (in the form of exams, interviews, presentations of research proposals or achievements), if it is provided by Admission Rules.

Entrant is exempted from passing the entrance exam in foreign language, if he has confirmed the level of English proficiency with a valid TOEFL test certificate, International English Language Testing System, or Cambridge English Language Assessment Certificate (not less than level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages or similar level); of German language with a valid TestDaF certificate (not less than level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages or similar level); of French language with a valid DELF or DALF certificate (not less than level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages or similar level). When measuring the results of the competition, these certificates are equated to the results of the entrance examination in a foreign language with the highest score.

In accordance with the Admission Rules of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” those who enter postgraduate (adjunct) in different fields of study than specified in their Master's (Specialist`s) Degree, additional entrance tests should be scheduled.

6. Other entrance tests and indicators of competitive selection are determined by the Admission Rules.

7. The score is calculated:

1) in accordance with the following formula to enter the first year to obtain Bachelor's Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education:

$$\text{Score (S)} = K1 \times P1 + K2 \times P2 + K3 \times P3 + K4 \times A + K5 \times PS + K6 \times TC;$$

in accordance with the following formula to enter the first year to obtain Junior Bachelor's Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education:

$$\text{Score (S)} = K1 \times P1 + K3 \times P3 + K4 \times A + K5 \times PS + K6 \times TC,$$

where

P1, P2 – grades on external independent evaluation or entrance exams on the first and second subjects;

P3 – grade on external independent evaluation, entrance exams on the third (to enter the study for Bachelor's Degree – on the second) subject or creative competition (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200);

A – GPA of the certificate of complete general secondary education, transferred into scaled tolerance from 100 to 200 in accordance with the table of GPA transfer of the certificate of complete general secondary education from 12 scaled tolerance into a scaled tolerance from 100 to 200 (Appendix 5);

TC– grade on successful completion of the preparatory courses of a higher educational institution for admission on a scaled tolerance from 100 to 200 in case of

admission to the programme subject areas (specializations) specified in the List of programme subject areas to which special support is provided;

PS – grade on personal statement, transferred into scaled tolerance from 100 to 200. The integral weighting factors K1, K2, K3, K4, K5, K6 are established by the higher educational institution to the nearest 0,01; K1, K2, K3 are established at a level of not less than 0.2 each; in case of a creative competition K3 should not exceed 0,25 (0,6 - for programme subject areas of fields of study 02 “Culture and arts” and programme subject area 191 “Architecture and urban planning”); K4 should not exceed 0,1; K5 should not exceed 0,01; K6 should not exceed 0,05. Summation of coefficients K1, K2, K3, K4, K5, K6 for each bid must be equal to 1.

Grades out of the certificate of complete general secondary education that are given in a 5-grade scaled tolerance are taken into the account: «3» corresponds «6», «4» corresponds «9», «5» corresponds «12». In the absence of the certificate of complete general secondary education for objective reasons its GPA in a 12 scaled tolerance is considered to be equal to 2.

Grades on the personal statement can be credited by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” only if the results of its evaluation are published on the website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” before the main session of the external independent evaluation.

Those, who are members of the national teams of Ukraine and participated in the international competitions (in accordance with the Orders of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine), Olympic, Paralympic and Deaflympic Games (at the Request of the Ministry of Youth and Sports of Ukraine) scores 200 grades on two entrance tests on the entrant's choice.

To winners of the European Championships and the World Olympic Sports Championships (particularly among schoolchildren), World Gymnasiade, Ukrainian championships (of the Olympic sports) during the admission to study in programme subject areas 014 “Secondary education (Physical Education)” and 017 “Physical Education and Sports” the last addition is set to 10, and if the score of the entrant exceeds 200 grades, it is set equal to 200 grades. A document confirming the status of the prize-winner or winner of these competitions is a diploma (charter, certificate, etc.), issued by the competition organizers with the definition of their own name and surname, competition`s name, date, venue, place and result.

To winners (persons awarded by diplomas of I-III degrees) of the IV stage of the All-Ukrainian Student Olympiads in the year of admission on basic subjects during the admission to the programme subject areas, which are provided with special support (Appendix 2 to the Terms of Admission), the last addition is set to 10, and if the score of the entrant exceeds 200 grades, it is set equal to 200 grades. Information about is received by the Admissions Committee out of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education.

The List of programme subject areas for participants of the State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” All-Ukrainian Student Olympiad to which special support is provided, in order to vocational guidance of entrants on the basis of complete general secondary education in programme subject areas, additional grades may be added to the external independent evaluation certificate in

one relevant subject when calculating the score at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” in the amount of 1 to 20 grades, but not more than 200 grades per subject. State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” All-Ukrainian Student Olympiad is held in accordance with the Regulations on State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” All-Ukrainian Student Olympiad for vocational guidance of entrants on the basis of complete general secondary education, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated December 21, 2016 No. 1587, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on January 10, 2017 No. 16/29884.

The score is finally multiplied by regional (RS), branch (BS) and rural (RS) scores by multiplying their amount, in which connections are following:

RS equals 1,00 for State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” bids; 1,04 – in Luhansk region.

BS equals 1,02 for submitted applications with priority 1 and 2 on programme subject areas (specializations), provided in the List of programme subject areas to which special support is provided; 1,00 – in other cases;

RS equals 1,02 for those registered in villages and who has completed general secondary education in educational institutions located in villages, in the year of entry (1,05 - on programme subject areas (specializations), provided in the List of programme subject areas to which special support is provided); 1,00 - in other cases.

Entrants provide a certificate of residence registration (if necessary) in accordance with Appendix 13 to the Rules of residence registration and the Procedure for information transfer by registration authorities to the Unified State Demographic Register, approved by the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated March 2, 2016 No. 207.

RS is not applicable for persons, who are internally displaced persons and live in village without registration.

The Admissions Committee checks the application of RS in accordance with the certificate of Appendix 13 of the Rules of residence registration and the Procedure for the information transfer by registration authorities to the Unified State Demographic Register, approved by the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated March 2, 2016 No. 207, submitted in paper form, and approves it by its decision, and enters information to the Unified State Electronic Database on Education. If entrant submits application in electronic form, the Admissions Committee checks the application of the RS in accordance with the certificate on the basis of its scanned copy (photocopy).

If after multiplying the coefficients the score exceeds 200 grades, it is set equal to 200 grades;

2) in accordance with the following formula to enter Master's Degree in the fields of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International relations”:

$$\text{Score (S)} = K1 \times P1 + K2 \times P2 + K3 \times P3,$$

where

P1 – grade of single entrance exam in foreign language or entrance test in foreign language in cases provided by these Terms (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200);

P2 - grade of subject unit of single professional entrance exam (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200);

P3 – grade of TGELC of single professional entrance exam (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200)

K1, K2, K3 - integral weighting factors, issued by the higher educational institution at a level of not less than 0,25 each. Summation of coefficients K1, K2, K3 for each bid must be equal to 1.

3) to enter Master's Degree in other programme subjects areas:

$$\text{Score (S)} = K1 \times P1 + K2 \times P2 + P3,$$

where

P1 – grade on single entrance exam in foreign language or entrance test in foreign language in cases provided by these Terms (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200);

P2 – grade on single professional entrance exam/single entrance exam on first (Bachelor`s) level in the relevant programme subject area, passed in the year of admission (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200);

P3 - grade on other bid indicators (including GPA of the document on the obtained educational degree (educational-qualification level), on the basis of which the entry is made) in accordance with the Admission Rules, if they are set (in scaled tolerance from 0 to 20 grades in total for all such indicators);

K1, K2 - integral weighting factors, issued by the higher educational institution at a level of not less than 0,25 each. Summation of coefficients K1, K2, K3 for each bid must be equal to 1.

4) in accordance with the following formula to enter Bachelor's Degree on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, the educational-professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, the educational degree of Junior Bachelor:

$$\text{Score (S)} = K1 \times P1 + K2 \times P2 + K3 \times P3,$$

where

P1, P2 - grades on external independent evaluation or entrance exams on the first and second subjects (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200);

P3 - grade on single professional entrance exam (scaled tolerance from 100 to 200)/results on the integrated exam KROK-M, transferred in to a scaled tolerance from 100 to 200 in accordance with the Table of result transfer of the integrated exam KROK-M into a scaled tolerance from 100 to 200 0 (Appendix 7);

K1, K2, K3 - integral weighting factors, issued by the higher educational institution at a level of not less than 0,25 each. Summation of coefficients K1, K2, K3 for each bid must be equal to 1.

5) in other cases score is calculated as a sum of grades for entrance test and other indicators of the bid in accordance with the Admission Rules.

8. In the absence of supplement to the document on the obtained educational degree (educational-qualification level), its GPA is considered to correspond to the minimum possible value.

If different number of components is in a score the principle of equality of right of entries adheres to.

9. Higher educational institution in the Admission Rules determines the minimum value of the number of grades of the entrance test (score) that entrant is allowed to participate in the competition with.

Score for admission on the basis of complete general secondary education may not be less than:

140 grades - for programme subject area of field of study 29 “International Relations”.

10. The results of entrance exams and creative competitions are evaluated on scaled tolerance from 100 to 200.

11. Interview programmes, which include the procedure for evaluating the results of the interview, are approved by the Chairman of the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” no later than March 31 of the given year of the admissions campaign.

Entrance exams are taken instead of external independent evaluation and are conducted in accordance with external independent evaluation programmes for entrants on the basis of complete general secondary education and for entrants on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor. Entrance exams in a foreign language for entrants of Master's Degree are conducted in accordance with the programme of a single entrance exam. The Chairman of the Admissions Committee approves the procedure for assessment based on the results of the entrance exam, which should include the structure of the final score.

Programmes of creative tests and the order of their evaluation are developed and approved by the Chairman of the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” no later than January 31 of the given year.

Programmes of creative tests, structure of the grade and the order of evaluation are developed and approved by the Chairman of the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” no later than March 31 of the given year. It is not allowed to include tasks that go beyond these programmes in creative competitions.

Programmes of interviews, entrance exams, vocational tests, creative tests and creative competitions should be published on the websites of higher educational institutions, and should contain the evaluation criteria, the evaluation structure and the procedure for evaluating the preparedness of entrants.

Evaluation criteria, evaluation structure and evaluation procedure of personal statements are developed and approved by the Chairman of the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” no later than one month before the admission of personal statements and are published on the website of the educational institution. At the same time, the Chairman of the Admissions Committee approves the commission`s composition for the evaluation of personal statements, which may include representatives of employers (by agreement).

12. Persons who without a good reason (recognized as such by the decision of the Admissions Committee) did not appear for the entrance exams at the scheduled time, persons whose knowledge was assessed by grades below the minimum value established by the Admission Rules, as well as persons who withdrew documents after the date of admission procedure, are not allowed to participate in the next entrance exams and competitive selection. Repositioning of entrance exams is not allowed.

13. Appeals against the results of entrance tests, conducted by the higher educational institution, are considered by the Appeal Commission of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, commissioners and modus operandi of which are approved by the Rector.

14. Information on the results of entrance tests and other competitive indicators about the entrant should be recorded in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education.

15. By the decision of the Admissions Committee the results of the entrance exam in the competitive subject for admission to a particular bid may be enrolled at the Request of the entrant to participate in the competitive selection for another bid at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”.

16. Official announcement of the results of creative competitions for state order places, including grades of individual sessions of creative competitions and information on achieving the minimum passing score is carried out by posting the relevant information on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and is recorded in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education no later than the next day after they are held.

VIII. Special conditions for participation in the competitive selection for higher education

1. Special conditions for participation in the competitive selection for higher education on the basis of complete general secondary education are:

- enrollment by the interview;
- participation in competitive selection by exams and/or quota-1, quota-2.

Special conditions for participation in the competitive selection for admission on the basis of the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor are participation in a competitive selection on exams.

Special conditions for participation in the competitive selection for admission on the basis of Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree (educational-qualification level of a Specialist) are participation in the competitive selection for exams at State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" instead of a single professional entrance exam and/or a single entrance exam.

Special conditions for higher education at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) and at the expense of targeted soft state loans on the basis of complete general secondary education are:

- enrollment based on the results of the interview, quota-1, quota-2 or quota-4 at the places of state order;
- enrollment under quota-3 in places of regional order;
- transfer to vacant places of state order of persons in the order provided by these Rules and Terms of Admission if they are enrolled in training on other sources of financing on the fixed bid;
- transfer to places at the expense of targeted soft state loans of persons in the manner prescribed by the laws, if they are enrolled in training at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities.

Information on persons entitled to special conditions for participation in the competitive selection at the time of admission is put in to the Unified State Electronic Database on Education (attaching scanned copies of documents confirming these rights).

2. Entrance examinations are held in the form of an interview and during the admission for higher education on the basis of complete general secondary education, in case of a positive conclusion of passing the interview, it is recommended to enroll:

persons with disabilities due to war in accordance with Article 7 of the Law of Ukraine "On status of war veterans, guarantees of their social protection" (in particular on the basis of the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor);

persons who by the Law of Ukraine "On the Status and Social Protection of Citizens Affected by Chornobyl Catastrophe", have been granted the right to be admitted to state higher educational institutions without examinations based on the results of an interview;

persons with disabilities who are unable to attend an educational institution (on the recommendation of the health and social protection authorities).

If such persons are recommended for enrollment in a fixed bid, they are enrolled in public procurement (unless the application states: "I apply to participate in the competition only for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, notified of the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to the state or regional order").

3. Entrance tests are held in the form of entrance exams (instead of external independent evaluation) and in case of obtaining the number of points for each exams not less than set by State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" as the minimum level is allowed to participate in the competitive

selection for higher education on the basis of complete general secondary education or the educational qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational and professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor for:

persons recognized as victims of the Revolution of Dignity and participants in hostilities in accordance with the Law of Ukraine “On status of war veterans, guarantees of their social protection”, including those who serve in the military (except national servicemen) in order prescribed by relevant provisions on passing of military service by citizens of Ukraine.

Persons of these categories participate in the competitive selection based on the results of entrance exams in year 2022 or external independent evaluation in years 2019-2022 (in any combination of their choice). If such persons are admitted to the competitive selection for a fixed bid on the basis of complete general secondary education, they participate in the competitive selection within quota-1 for public procurement: (unless the application states: “I apply to participate in the competition only for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, notified of the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to the state or regional order”).

4. Entrance tests are held in the form of entrance exams (instead of external independent evaluation) and in case of obtaining the number of grades for each exam, that is not less than the minimum level set by the higher educational institution, it is allowed to participate in the competitive selection for higher education on the basis of complete general secondary education or the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational degree Professional Junior Bachelor, Junior Bachelor's Degree to:

persons who, in accordance with the decision of the Regulatory Commission at the Regional Center for Educational Quality Assessment, were denied in registration for participation in 2022 external independent evaluation due to the impossibility of creating special (specific) conditions (subject to submission to the Admission Committee of higher educational institution of a medical certificate № 086-3/o “Medical opinion on the creation of special (specific) conditions for external independent evaluation”, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science and the Ministry of Health dated August 29, 2016 No. 1027/900 “Some issues of participation in external independent evaluation and entrance exams of persons, certain diseases and/or pathological conditions, disabilities”, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on December 27, 2016 under No. 1707/29837, certified by the signature of the Secretary of the Regulatory Commission at the Regional Center for Educational Quality Assessment and the seal of the Regional Center for Educational Quality Assessment, and the corresponding Extract from the Minutes of the Regulatory Commission at the Regional Center for Educational Quality Assessment).

Such persons participate in the competitive selection based on the results of the entrance exams of 2022 and/or external independent evaluation of years 2019-2021 (in any combination of their choice). If such persons are admitted to the competitive selection for a fixed bid on the basis of a complete general secondary education, they

participate in the competitive selection within the quota-1 for public procurement (unless the application states: “I apply to participate in the competition exclusively for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, notified of the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to places of state or regional order”).

For entrants from among visually impaired people who use Braille in the learning process and need to create a special condition under Code 0205 List of special (specific) conditions created for persons with special educational needs in the points of external independent evaluation, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the Ministry of Health of Ukraine dated August 29, 2016 No. 1027/900, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on December 27, 2016 under No. 1708/29838, entrance tests in Geography, Physics, Chemistry, English, Spanish, German and French are held at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”.

5. They take entrance tests in the form of entrance exams instead of external independent evaluation (if they did not make an external independent evaluation of relevant subjects in 2022) and in case of receiving the number of grades for each exams not less than the minimum level set by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” are allowed to participate in the competitive selection for admission to higher education on the basis of complete general secondary education or the educational qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational and professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor:

persons who in 2022 did not participate in the main and additional sessions of external independent evaluation in a particular subject(s) due to the presence of a disease or pathological condition, specified in the List of diseases and pathological conditions that may be an obstacle to passing external independent evaluation, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the Ministry of Health of Ukraine dated August 29, 2016 No. 1027/900, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on December 27, 2016 under № 1707/29837 (subject to submission to the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” one of the documents specified in Item 1 of Paragraph 2 of the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, Ministry of Health of Ukraine dated August 29, 2016 No. 1027/900 “Some issues of participation in external independent evaluation and entrance exams of persons, certain diseases and/or pathological conditions, disabilities”, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on December 27, 2016 under No. 1707/29837, or copies of such a document).

Such persons participate in the competitive selection based on the results of entrance exams in certain subject(s), of which did not participate in the main and additional sessions of the external independent evaluation in year 2022, and/or external independent evaluation 2019-2022 (in any combination of their choice). If such persons are admitted to the competitive selection for a fixed bid on the basis of complete general secondary education, they participate in the competitive selection within the quota-1 for the places of the state order (unless the application states: “I apply to participate in the competition exclusively for places at the expense of

individuals and/or legal entities, notified of the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to places of state or regional order”).

If persons referred to in Paragraphs 2-5 of this Section have expressed a desire to participate in the competitive selection only on the basis of the results of an external independent evaluation, they participate in the competitive selection within the quota-1 based on the following results.

6. Entrance tests in the form of entrance exams (instead of external independent evaluation) to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, determined in accordance with the Order No. 271, and in case of obtaining the number of grades that is allowed to participate in the competitive selection for each exam that is not less than the minimum level set by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” are passed by:

persons whose place of residence is temporarily occupied territory of certain districts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions, the territory of settlements on the contact line, temporarily occupied territory of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol (who are not registered as internally displaced persons) or moved out of it after January 1, 2022.

Such persons participate in the competitive selection based on the results of entrance exams (taking into account the peculiarities of passing the state final certification in the Educational Centers "Crimea-Ukraine", "Donbas-Ukraine" or without such consideration for persons who have received a document of complete general secondary education) and/or external independent evaluation (in any combination of their choice). If citizens of Ukraine from among such persons are admitted to the competitive selection for a fixed bid, they participate in the competitive selection within quota-2 for places of state order (unless the application states: “I apply to participate in the competition only for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, reported on the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to the places of state or regional order”).

7. Entrance tests are held in the form of entrance exams (instead of external independent evaluation and if they did not pass an external independent evaluation on relevant subjects in 2022) and in the case of receiving the number of grades for each exam not less than the minimum level set by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” for allowance to participate in the competitive selection:

persons discharged from military service starting from December 1, 2021 inclusively;

citizens of Ukraine who received a complete general secondary education abroad in the period between September 1, 2021 and November 30, 2022.

Persons of these categories participate in the competitive selection based on the results of entrance exams and/or external independent evaluation (results of entrance exams are counted in subjects from which the entrant did not pass the external independent evaluation). Persons referred to in Paragraph 3 of this Section participate in the competitive selection for public procurement only in case of admission just on the basis of external independent evaluation.

8. In the competitive selection within quota-1 for places of state or regional order (unless the application states: “I apply to participate in the competition exclusively for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, notified of the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to the places of state or regional order”) can participate:

orphans, children deprived of parental care, persons from among them.

9. In the competitive selection within quota-4 for public procurement (unless the application states: “I apply to participate in the competition exclusively for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, notified of the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to the places of state or regional order”) can participate:

persons who have the right to priority enrollment for higher (professional higher) medical, artistic and pedagogical education in accordance with Paragraph 4 of Part 3 of Article 44 of the Law of Ukraine “On Higher Education” and the Procedure for exercising the right to priority enrollment at institutions of higher (professional higher) medical, artistic and pedagogical education by state order of persons, who have concluded an agreement on working for at least three years in a rural area or urban-type settlement, approved by the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated May 30, 2018 No. 417.

10. Persons who use special conditions for participation in the competitive selection for higher education by state order and at the expense of targeted soft state loans on the basis of complete general secondary education in accordance with Paragraphs 2-6, 8-10 of this Section and have not been included in the state order, have the right to participate in the competition on a general basis in accordance with the score.

11. Subject to transfer from places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities to vacant places of the state order according to these Rules and Terms of Admission, if they are enrolled in other sources of funding for a fixed bid and have not received a recommendation for public procurement:

1) persons whose parents died (went missing) in the area of the anti-terrorist operation, the implementation of measures to ensure national security and defense, repulse and deter the armed aggression of the Russian Federation in Donetsk and Luhansk regions, fighting or armed conflict or has died as a result of injury, contusion or mutilation, obtained in the area of the anti-terrorist operation, the implementation of measures to ensure national security and defense, repulse and deter the armed aggression of the Russian Federation in Donetsk and Luhansk regions, hostilities or armed conflicts, as well as a result of illness acquired during the period of participation in the anti-terrorist operation, implementation of measures to ensure national security and defense, repulse and deter armed aggression of the Russian Federation in Donetsk and Luhansk regions;

2) persons whose parents died or were injured as a result of injury, mutilation, contusion or other damage to health received during the Revolution of Dignity;

3) persons whose parents are participants in hostilities on the territory of other states, who died (went missing) or died as a result of injury, contusion or mutilation received during hostilities and conflicts in the territory of other states, as well as due to illness associated with being in the territory of other states during these actions and conflicts;

4) persons whose one of the parents (adoptive parents) was a serviceman who died or was declared missing by a court during his military service;

5) persons whose one of the parents (adoptive parents) was a policeman who died or was declared missing by a court during his military service, within three years after obtaining the relevant general secondary education;

12. To vacant places of state order according to these Rules and Terms of Admission, if they are enrolled in training on other sources of funding for a fixed bid and have not received a recommendation for public procurement the following persons can be transferred:

persons with disabilities of I and II groups, and children with disabilities under the age of 18 who are not contraindicated in their chosen specialty;

persons with disabilities from among the participants in the liquidation of the consequences of the Chernobyl accident and victims of the Chernobyl disaster, in respect of which the causal link between the disability and the Chernobyl disaster has been established, patients suffering from radiation sickness as a result of the Chernobyl catastrophe (category 1) and persons who permanently lived in the zone of unconditional (compulsory) resettlement from the moment of the accident until the adoption of the resolution on resettlement (category 2);

children of persons (as well as persons from among them who have completed general secondary education in the year of entry), recognized as victims of the Revolution of Dignity, participants in hostilities, persons with disabilities as a result of the war, in accordance with the Law of Ukraine “On the status of war veterans, guarantees of their social protection”;

miners with at least three years of underground work experience, as well as within three years after obtaining a general secondary education of a person, whose parents are miners and have experience of underground work for at least 15 years or who died as a result of an accident at work or became persons with disabilities of I or II group;

persons who use special conditions for participation in the competitive selection for higher education by state order and at the expense of targeted soft state loans based on complete general secondary education in accordance with Items 2-6 and 8 of this Section and have not been enrolled in public procurement (unless the relevant statements state: “I apply to participate in the competition exclusively for places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, notified of the impossibility of transfer within the introductory campaign to places of state or regional order”).

13. Can be transferred to vacant places of the state order according to these Rules and Terms of Admission, if they are enrolled in training on other sources of funding for a fixed bid, as well as in places at the expense of targeted soft state loans

of persons in the order provided by laws, if they are enrolled in training at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, and have not received recommendation for public procurement:

persons who are internally displaced persons in accordance with the Law of Ukraine “On Ensuring the Rights and Freedoms of Internally Displaced Persons”;
children from large families (five or more children).

14. When entering a Master's Degree in the field of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International relations” participate in the competitive selection based on the results of entrance exams at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” (instead of single entrance exam in a foreign language and single professional entrance exam) and when entering the study for Master's Degree in all other programme subject areas (instead of single entrance exam in a foreign language):

persons who are unable to take part in single entrance exam and/or single professional entrance exam due to the presence of diseases specified in the List of diseases and pathological conditions that may be an obstacle to external independent evaluation, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and the Ministry of Health of Ukraine dated August 29, 2016 No. 1027/900, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on December 27, 2016 under No. 1707/29837;

persons who, in order to complete single entrance exam and/or single professional entrance exam, require special conditions, than are specified in the List of special (specific) conditions created for persons with special educational needs in the points of external independent evaluation, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the Ministry of Health of Ukraine dated August 29, 2016 No. 1027/900, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on December 27, 2016 under No. 1708/29838, under codes 0101–0105, 0201–0203, 0206, 0301–0306, 0401, 0501, 0601, 0701, 0702;

entrants discharged from all types of military service starting from April 1, 2022.

15. When applying for higher education at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities on bids, who in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission provide for single entrance exam and/or single professional entrance exam, entrants on the basis of Master's Degree (educational qualification level of Specialist) may, at their choice, either submit the result(s) of single entrance exam and/or single professional entrance exam, or pass the relevant entrance exam(s) at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”.

16. When entering the study for Master's Degree in the fields of study 05 “Social and Behavioral Science”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International Relations”, the persons specified in Items 3, 12, and Paragraph 4 of Item 13 of Section IX of the Terms of Admission are subject to transfer from places at the

expense of individuals and/or legal entities to vacant places of the state order according to these Rules and Terms of Admission, if they are enrolled in training on other sources of funding for a fixed bid and have not received a recommendation for public procurement.

IX. Ranking lists of entrants and recommendations for enrollment

1. Ranking lists of entrants are formed by all the categories in the following order:

entrants, who have the right to enroll based on the results of the interview (on the basis of complete general secondary education and on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Professional Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor);

entrants, who have the right to enroll based on quotas (only on the basis of complete general secondary education);

entrants who have the right to enroll on general terms.

2. Entrants who are eligible for admission based on the results of the interview are sorted alphabetically.

Within other categories specified in Item 1 of this Section, the rating list of entrants is arranged:

by score - from higher to lower;

by priority of the application from the first to the last;

by score of single professional entrance exam;

in accordance with the GPA of the supplement to the document on the obtained educational (educational-qualification) level - from higher to lower.

If rules set out in Paragraphs 3-5 of this Item do not allow to determine the sequence of entrants in the ranking list, the Admissions Committee makes a decision independently based on the analysis of documents submitted by entrants and is put in to the Unified State Electronic Database on Education.

3. The rating list of entrants indicates:

higher educational degree, programme subject area, name of bid, mode of study;

last name, first name, patronymic (if any) of the entrant;

score of the entrant (except those enrolled by the interview);

the priority of the application specified by the entrant (only for bids that use priority);

indication of grounds for enrollment based on the results of the interview, quota-1, quota-2, quota-4, quota for foreigners (only on the basis of complete general secondary education);

the GPA of the supplement to the document on the obtained educational degree (educational-qualification level) (only if it is taken into account on the score).

Entrant`s names whose places of residence are certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions that are temporarily occupied territory of Ukraine, territory of the

settlements located on the contact line, temporarily occupied Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol, (who are not registered as Internally Displaced Persons) or who are moved out of it after January 1, 2022 are to be encrypted in all information systems.

4. Ranking lists are formed by the Admissions Committee out of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education and are published in full on the website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”. Promulgation of current ranking lists of entrants takes place on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” based on data, entered into the Unified State Electronic Database on Education. State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” can provide links to the relevant page of the institution in the relevant information system on their official website instead of current ranking lists of entrants` promulgation on the official website which provides information to the public on the basis of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education data.

5. Lists of entrants recommended for enrollment at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) at each bid are received by the Admissions Committee in accordance with the data of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education, checked for the accuracy of the information submitted by the entrants and compliance with the requirements for the formation of lists provided by these Rules and Terms of Admission, in particular the requirements of the Materials for the technical task development of the algorithm of targeted placement of the state order in the year 2022 (hereinafter – the Materials for the technical task development), listed in Appendix 6 to these Rules and Terms of Admission, and are approved by the decision of the Admissions Committee and published by placing them on the Admissions Committee`s information stands and on the website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” in accordance with terms, defined in Section V of the Terms of Admission.

List of entrants recommended for enrollment should contain same data, as in the rating list of entrants in accordance with Item 3 of this Section.

6. Targeted placement of state-funded places for enrollment for Junior Bachelor, Bachelor (Master of Medical, Pharmaceutical and Veterinary Specialties) based on complete general secondary education (Full-time and Intermittent (Off-Campus) modes of study) and entrants for Master's Degree by programme subject areas of fields of study 05 “Social and behavioral sciences”, 06 “Journalism”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 07 “Management and Administration”, 28 “Public Management and Administration”, 29 “International Relations” (Full-time and Intermittent (Off-Campus) modes of study) by bids on the basis of obtained Bachelor's Degree is formed at the Unified State Electronic Database on Education based on competitive points, priorities and ordering of the rating list of entrants taking into account the general, maximum volumes, qualification minimum of the state order. The entrant may be recommended for enrollment in the highest priority among those specified by him when submitting applications, in accordance with which the entrant is among those who can be recommended for enrollment, financed

by the state order, in accordance with his score. Terms of implementation reference of targeted placement of state-funded places are formed in accordance with the Materials for the development of Terms of Reference.

7. Publication of enrollment recommendations is considered to be published on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, based on data of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education, relevant information, certified by a qualified electronic signature of the Chairman of the Admissions Committee or Executive Secretary of the Admissions Committee, as well as in the electronic office of the entrant.

Entrants recommended for enrollment may be notified by electronic and mobile means in accordance with the Admission Rules.

X. Realization of entrants` right to choose a place of study

1. Persons who have submitted applications in paper or electronic forms and who participate in the competitive selection for state order, after the decision of the Admissions Committee on the recommendation for enrollment in accordance with the term, defined in Section V of these Rules and the Terms of Admission or in accordance with them, are obliged to fulfill the enrollment requirements in the state-funded places: to personally submit the originals of the document on the educational (educational-qualification) level and the supplement to it, certificates of external independent evaluation and/or other documents, provided by these Rules and Terms of Admission to the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, as well as to conclude training agreement between State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and entrant (with the participation of parents or legal representatives - for minor entrants).

Submission of originals of the necessary documents for enrollment may be made in addition to personal submission by:

sending their scanned copies, with the overlapping of the entrant`s qualified electronic signature on relevant files to the Admissions Committee`s email of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”, indicated in the Register of subjects of educational activity at the Unified State Electronic Database on Education in terms, defined in Section V of these Rules and Terms of Admission or in accordance with it. If within ten calendar days after the start of training the entrant does not provide the origin of documents, the enrollment order is cancelled in terms of enrollment of such a person.

Training contract (regardless of funding source) between State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and entrant (with the participation of parents or legal representatives - for minor entrants) is a basis for issuing an order of enrollment. If the entrant has fulfilled the requirements for enrollment without personal submission of documents, the enrollment order can be issued without concluding a contract. If the training contract is not fulfilled within ten calendar days after the start of training, the enrollment order is canceled in terms of enrollment of such a person.

The submitted originals of documents are stored at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” during the entire period of study. Entrant, whose last name, first name or patronymic (if any) has changed after receiving a document of education (on the basis of which the entry is made), he additionally personally presents the certificate on state registration of acts of civil status on the relevant change and the document issued on its basis, identifying the person whose information is entered into the Unified State Electronic Database on Education to the Admissions Committee of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”. Persons who have submitted applications in an electronic form, in addition, are required to sign their own statement printed by the Admissions Committee.

In a case of admission at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, in addition, an agreement is concluded between State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” and individual (legal) entity, who orders a paid educational service for himself or for another person, assuming financial obligations to pay it.

2. Persons who received a recommendation for the state-funded places and in the established terms, defined in Section V of these Rules and Terms of Admission or in accordance with it, failed to meet the requirements for enrollment in places of state order (except for the cases specified in Section XIII of these Rules and Terms of Admission), lose the right to enroll (transfer) to study by state order in the current year.

Persons, who received a recommendation for the state-funded places and in the established terms, defined in Section V of these Rules and Terms of Admission or in accordance with it, fulfilled the requirements for enrollment in state-funded places, should be enrolled.

3. The procedure of the realization of right of entrants to choose a place of study at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities is determined by the Admission Rules.

4. In the case of simultaneous study in several programme subject areas (fields of study, specializations, educational programmes) and modes of study, originals of the document on educational (educational-qualification) level, supplement to the state standard, as well as the originals of certificates of external independent evaluation that are kept at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” at the place of study by state order or at the expense of targeted soft state loan during the entire period of study.

In the case of simultaneous study in several programme subject areas (fields of study, specializations, educational programmes) and modes of study at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, the originals of the above documents are stored in one of the higher educational institutions on the student's choice throughout the term of study. Certificate of storage of original documents and certified copies of relevant documents are issued on the student's request by the higher educational institution where they are stored.

XI. Adjustment of recommended for enrollment list

1. The Admissions Committee cancels previously submitted recommendations to entrants who have not met the requirements for enrollment in public procurement, provided in Item 1 of Section X of these Rules and Terms of Admission.

2. The lists of those who are recommended for enrollment are updated after the fulfillment/non-fulfillment by the entrants for Bachelor's Degree on the basis of the educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor, for Master's Degree on the basis of Bachelor's Degree (educational-qualification level of Specialist) (except for programme subject areas 05 "Social and behavioral sciences", 06 "Journalism", 07 "Management and Administration", 28 "Public Management and Administration", 29 "International Relations"), for obtaining Doctor of Philosophy Degree requirements for enrollment in accordance with Section X of these Terms, taking into account their priority in the rating list of entrants.

When updating lists of recommended for enrollment in Bachelor's Degree on the basis of educational-qualification level of Junior Specialist, educational-professional degree of Junior Bachelor, educational degree of Junior Bachelor, regardless of the score of recommendations for enrollment are given to entrants specified in Items 3, 12 - 14 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission and these Admission Rules, if they are admitted to the competitive selection.

3. Entrants recommended for study at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities are obliged to fulfill the requirements for enrollment in accordance with Paragraph 1 of Section X of these Rules and Terms of Admission.

In case of enrollment at the expense of individuals (legal) entities within ten calendar days from the date of the start of training, an additional agreement is concluded between State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" and an individual (legal) entity, who orders a paid educational service for himself or for another person, assuming financial obligations to pay for it. In case of refusal to enter into an agreement within the period specified in this Paragraph, this order is revoked in terms of enrollment of such person. Tuition is paid in accordance with the agreement between the higher educational institution and the individual (legal) entity, who orders a paid educational service for himself or for another person, assuming financial obligations to pay for it.

4. The procedure for adjusting the list of recommended for enrollment at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities are determined by the Admission Rules.

XII. Transfer to state order vacant places of persons who are enrolled in training at the expense of individuals, legal entities

1. State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" independently provides recommendations for targeted placement of state-funded places to entrants within bids (except for non-budget bids), for which recommendations were provided for admission to State Institution "Luhansk Taras

Shevchenko National University” in accordance with the relevant bid in the order, provided for in Item 6 of Section IX of the Terms of Admission and these Rules, and subsequently canceled in accordance with Item 1 of Section XI of the Terms of Admission.

2. The right to transfer from places at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities to vacant places of the state order is used by persons who have not received recommendations for enrollment in places of the state order.

3. The transfer to vacant places of the state order of persons enrolled at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities on the basis of complete general secondary education is carried out in the following sequence:

persons specified in Item 12 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission and these Rules, regardless on the score;

persons specified in Item 8 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission and these Rules;

persons specified in Item 13 of Section VIII of these Terms of Admission and these Rules, if the score received by them is less than the passing score (minimum score, which gave the opportunity to receive a recommendation for enrollment in public procurement for this bid for the general competition in the manner prescribed by Item 6 of Section IX of the Terms of Admission and these Rules) not more than 15 grades (25 grades for programme subject areas defined in the List of programme subject areas that receive special support);

persons specified in Item 14 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission and these Rules, if the score received by them is less than the passing score by not more than 15 grades (only for programme subject areas defined in the List of specialties that receive special support);

persons who have not received recommendations for enrollment in public procurement in the manner, provided for in Item 6 of Section IX of these Terms of Admission and these Rules (only for programme subject areas defined in the List of programme subject areas that receive special support), if their score is not less than the special passing score established by the Admissions Committee the day after the announcement of the targeted placement of budget places.

If persons who have not completed their studies at the expense of the state or local budget (by state order) at a certain level of higher education and received a recommendation for enrollment in the state order in the manner, provided for in Item 6 of Section IX of the Terms of Admission and these Rules, however, did not start due to the impossibility of reimbursement to the state budget of funds spent on training services, in accordance with the Procedure for reimbursement of state or local budget funds spent on training services, approved by the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated August 26, 2015 No. 658, the following vacancies of the state order may be transferred to the vacancies of the state order vacated in this order of those who did not receive recommendations for enrollment in the places of the state order as of the date of transfer (in agreement with the state customer).

Transfer to vacancies of the state order of persons, referred to in Paragraphs 2-5 of this Item, is carried out in the absence of not-transferred persons of the previous category or in case of their written refusal to transfer and in the sequence from the highest to the lowest place in the ranking list within each of these categories.

4. In case of lack of sufficient places for transfer to vacant places of the state order, State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” uses vacancies of the state order from other programme subject areas of this branch (only for persons specified in Paragraphs 2-5 of Item 3 of this Section), and in their absence - other fields of study (only for persons specified in Paragraphs 2-4 of Item 3 of this Section) this or that mode of study (after the transfer to vacant places of the state order of the persons specified in Paragraph 3 of this Section in the relevant programme subject area and mode of study), immediately notifies the relevant state customer.

Unused places of the state order are considered as not placed at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”. State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” informs the state customer about their number in terms of programme subject areas (specializations) and modes of study. In the absence of a sufficient number of places for transfer to vacant places of the state order of the persons specified in Paragraph 3 of Item 3 of this Section, State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” sends a request to the state customer for the allocation of additional places of the state order at the expense of the returned ones. The decision on the use of these places is made by the bid commission of the state customer.

XIII. Enrollment order, additional competitive tender, enrolling due to the targeted soft state loan

1. Orders on enrollment are issued by the Rector of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” on the basis of decision of the Admissions Committee. Enrollment orders with appendices to them are formed in Unified State Electronic Database on Education and are published on the website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” in the form of a list of enrolled within the time limits set in Section V of the Terms of Admission and these Rules or in accordance with it.

2. The decision of the Admissions Committee on the enrollment of entrant may be cancelled by the Admissions Committee in case of the entrant violations, provided in Item 5 of Section XVI of the Terms of Admission and these Rules.

Enrolled persons may be removed from the enrollment order (the enrollment order is cancelled in the part concerning this person) to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” upon his own request. Those expelled from State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” are able to return documents submitted by them upon their own request no later than the next day after submitting the application for dismissal.

3. If a person does not start classes without good reason within ten calendar days from the date of the commencement, the enrollment order is cancelled in the part concerning this person.

4. An additional competitive selection may be held for vacant place(s) in accordance with the procedure provided for in Items 2 and 3 of this Section (in agreement with the state customer) from among persons who participated in the contest for this bid. Entrants who submitted an application for this competitive proposal and were admitted to the competition take part in the additional competitive selection in accordance with the score. In the absence of such candidates for vacancies, it is allowed to enroll persons from bids of State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University", provided that the entrance exams coincide by transferring the application (with the consent of the person) to another bid.

Additional competitive selection is held until September 15, and orders on enrollment of such persons are formed and submitted to Unified State Electronic Database on Education by 18:00 on September 19.

5. The decision on the enrollment of the entrant with payment for his education at the expense of the targeted soft state loan is made on the application of the entrant submitted to the Admissions Committee, based on the results of participation in the competition in accordance with these Rules and Terms of Admission.

Preemptive right to enroll (transfer) to places financed by a target soft loan, have the persons specified in Paragraph 14 of Section VIII of the Terms of Admission and these Rules. Other categories of entrants have the right to enroll (transfer) to places, financed by the targeted soft state loan, is provided in the absence of persons of the above category or their written refusal of such places.

Applications of entrants enrolled under the state order for Bachelor's Degree on the basis of complete general secondary education and Master's Degree in programme subject areas 05 "Social and behavioral sciences", 06 "Journalism", 07 "Management and administration", 28 "Public Management and Administration", 29 "International Relations", are excluded from competitions for other places at the expense of individuals or legal entities, except in cases when the entrant submits a separate application during the fulfillment of the requirements for enrollment on places of state order, provided for in Item 1 of Section X of the Terms of Admission and these Rules.

XIV. Peculiarities of admission to higher educational institutions foreigners and stateless persons

1. Admission of foreigners and stateless persons to study at State Institution "Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University" is carried out in accordance with the Laws of Ukraine "On Higher Education", "On the Legal Status of Foreigners and Stateless Persons", "On foreign Ukrainians", "On Refugees and Persons in Need of Additional or Temporary Protection", by the Decree of the President of Ukraine dated June 3, 1994 No. 271 "On measures for the development of economic cooperation of regions of Ukraine with adjacent regions of the Republic of Belarus and

administrative-territorial units of the Republic of Moldova”, by the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated September 12, 2018 No. 729 “The issue of higher education by certain categories of persons”, by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated November 1, 2013 No. 1541 “Some issues of organization of recruitment and training (internship) of foreigners and stateless persons”, registered at the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 25, 2013 under No. 2004/24536, by Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated December 2, 2019 No. 1498 “On approval of the Procedure for establishing quotas for higher education by foreigners and stateless persons within the scope of the state order in accordance with international treaties of Ukraine”, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on February 10, 2020 under No. 153/34436.

2. Foreigners and stateless persons (hereinafter - foreigners) may obtain higher education at the funds of individuals and/or entities, if otherwise is not provided by international agreements of Ukraine, consent to be bound by Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, legislation or agreements between State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” on international academic mobility.

Admission of foreigners to higher educational institutions at the expense of government funding is carried out within the quotas for foreigners (except for foreigners and stateless persons, in particular foreign Ukrainians permanently residing in Ukraine, persons recognized as refugees and persons in need of additional protection).

Admission of foreigners is carried out for accredited educational programmes.

3. Enrollment of entrants from among foreigners to study at the funds of individuals and/or entities may be carried out by State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”:

1) twice a year, before and at the beginning of academic semesters (but no later than November 1 and March 1, respectively), for the degree of Junior Bachelor, Bachelor, Master;

2) during the year for postgraduate, adjunct and doctoral studies.

State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” calculates points/grades of the entrant on the basis of a document on previous level of education and sets the minimum required for entry value of the number of points/grades in general education subjects for which the entrance test is conducted.

Enrollment of foreigners on the appropriate level of higher education is based on the results of entrance exams in certain subjects and languages of study and on the basis of academic rights to continue their studies, provided by the document on the level of education obtained in the country of origin, and taking into account achievement points that entitle them to continue their education at the next level of higher education in accordance with the legislation of the country that issued the document on the degree (level) of education.

4. All categories of foreigners entering their studies are enrolled at State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” on the basis of

enrollment orders. Certificate generated in Unified State Electronic Database on Education can be a confirmation of the training.

5. Requirements of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” on the compliance of entrants from among foreigners who came to Ukraine to study, the conditions of admission to the appropriate levels of higher education, as well as deadlines for accepting applications and documents, conducting entrance exams, creative competitions and enrollment are specified in the Admission Rules and are published on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”.

6. Foreigners who receive state scholarships under international treaties, national programmes, and other international obligations of Ukraine are accepted for training within the established quotas for foreigners on the basis of directions of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

7. Foreigners who come to Ukraine to participate in academic mobility programmes or to obtain higher education in accordance with the educational programmes agreed between Ukrainian and foreign institutions of higher education are accepted for study taking into account the contractual obligations of the relevant higher educational institutions.

8. Foreigners and stateless persons, in particular foreign Ukrainians permanently residing in Ukraine, persons recognized as refugees and persons in need of additional protection, have the right to higher education on an equal footing with citizens of Ukraine, in particular by the state order or local budget, with the exceptions established by the Constitution of Ukraine, Laws of Ukraine or international treaties, the binding nature of which has been approved by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.

Foreign Ukrainians whose status is certified by a foreign Ukrainian certificate (except for persons permanently residing in Ukraine) may enroll in state-ordered education within the established quotas for foreigners by interview in subjects covered by the Admission Rules.

XV. Ensuring openness and transparency at the time of admission to higher educational institutions

1. At the meeting of the Admissions Committee the educational Ombudsman and/or the employee of the Educational Ombudsman Service, and representatives of the mass media (not more than two people from one mass media) have the right to be present. The Admission Rules determine the procedure for accreditation of journalists in the Admissions Committee.

2. Community organizations may apply to the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine to grant them the right to observe the work of Admissions Committee. Community organizations to whom such a right is granted by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine may send their observers to the meetings of the Admissions Committees. Admissions Committees are obliged to

create appropriate conditions for the presence of public observers on their meetings, as well as to provide them with the opportunity to familiarize them with documents that are given to the members of the Admissions Committee.

3. State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” is obliged to create conditions for acquainting entrants with a license to conduction of educational activities, certificates of accreditation of the relevant programme subject area (field of study, educational programme). Admission rules, information on the licensed volume and volume of admission by state order for each bid (programme subject area, educational programme, field of study) and degree, in particular the number of places allocated to admission by quotas published on the website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” no later than the working day, following the day of approval or receipt of relevant information.

State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” publishes information on the order of settlement and the availability of free places in students` residences on its official website no later than July 14.

4. The Chairman of the Admissions Committee announces meeting of the commission no later than the day before the day of the meeting, in special cases – no later than three hours before the meeting. The announcement together with the draft agenda for meeting is published on the official website of State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University”.

5. State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” to which the entrants were admitted, who provided certificates of health care institutions to confirm the special conditions for participation in the competitive selection or special conditions for higher education by the expence of the state or local budget (by state order), and at the expense of targeted soft state loans, should make a request to the relevant health-care establishment to confirm special conditions within one month from the date of enrollment, but no later than November 15. Inquiries from higher educational institutions and health-care establishment responses are uploaded to the Unified State Electronic Database on Education.

6. Submission the incorrect personal data, incorrect previous education information, the existence of the right to secure the quotas, the right to special participation in the competitive selection or special conditions for higher education by the expence of the state or local budget (by state order), participation in student competitions, passing the external independent evaluation, common entrance examination, common single professional entrance exam by the entrant is the basis for cancellation the enrollment order in the part concerning that entrant.

7. Informing the public about the licensed volume, the amount of places funded by the state order, the cost of training in programme subject areas (fields of study, specializations, educational programmes), persons (names and initials) who have applied for admission, their recommendations for enrollment to State Institution “Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University” is carried out by information systems based on data of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education in "Entry" Section via the link: <https://vstup.edbo.gov.ua/>, as well as information

systems (in accordance with agreements concluded by the owners (commodity managers) of such systems with the technical administrator of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education).

8. The list of those who submitted documents for the wide competition is published in the “Entry” Section of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education via the link: <https://vstup.edbo.gov.ua/> at least twice during the period of acceptance of applications and documents.
